

Student and Resident Candidates Campaign Rules and Activities for MAFP and MAFPF Board of Directors

Election:

It is the intent of the MS Academy of Family Physicians that there shall be one (1) student board member and one (1) alternate student board member from each medical school for a total of 4 student board member positions. In addition, it is also our intent that the resident board positions will rotate the 4 positions among the 6 residencies, based upon application and interest. Two residents will be resident board members and 2 will be alternate resident board members. Board members will be elected to serve a 1-year term (May 2022 – May 2023)

Campaign Rules:

Candidates must indicate the Board of Directors position (MAFP or MAFP Foundation) for which they are applying on their application. Candidates may only run for 1 board position in a given election. Application and additional required documents must be received via mail, fax or email no later than Wednesday, April 6, 2022.

Students and residents applying for the board positions will campaign for election to the MAFP or MAFP Foundation Board on Saturday, April 23, 2022, at the Spring Fling Conference. Each candidates' letter of interest, current CV and photo will be displayed in a common area for members to review. Additional campaigning is optional, and is limited to a one pager that may include the candidate's qualifications, campaign platform, etc.

During the conference, all candidates will introduce themselves by giving a speech no longer than 3 minutes.

Votina:
