Knowledge Self-Assessment

Knowledge Self-Assessment (KSA) Study Groups give you credit for your maintenance of certification through the American Board of Family Medicine. Learners complete the KSA with family physician instructors by working through 60 core competency questions. Learners work together to assess, review, and decide the best answer as a group. *ABFM awards 8 credits to diplomates who complete each session.*

CME Activities

Accreditation

This program has been applied for Prescribed Credits by the American Academy of Family Physicians. This includes evidence based credit. AAFP Prescribed Credit is accepted by the American Medical Association (AMA) as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 Credit toward the AMA Physician's Recognition Award. When applying for the AMA PRA, prescribed credit earned must be reported as prescribed credit, not as Category 1. Following this CME activity, participants will have the opportunity to earn an additional two Prescribed credits for participation in each Translation to Practice® exercise. Learners who wish to participate must complete the Commitment to Change Form. In 90 days, the learner will confirm implementation of the change identified in the Commitment to Change Form. The learner reviews and completes the required reflection questions in Part 2 and sends back the completed form to the chapter.

Program Objectives

This activity is designed for the specialty of family medicine, but may also be of educational interest to the specialties of internal medicine, pediatrics and other primary care fields. It is designed to introduce providers to the latest information, techniques and technology applicable to office-based patient care through didactic lectures and interactive discussions. Upon completion of this program, participants should have a working and applicable comprehension of these topics. Specific objectives for each topic will be included in the participant syllabus.
